

6 At The Green School for Girls high achievement is a priority, and each year the school celebrates consistently excellent examination results.



7 The Green School for Boys opened in September 2017 under shared leadership with The Green School for Girls.



8 The Bishop Wand School is proud of its reputation for exceptional pastoral care and academic achievement and ensures that all students develop as high achieving, confident, articulate young people who most importantly enjoy education.



9 Chelsea Academy hold the Investors in People Gold award. Staff CPD is a priority.



10 Lady Margaret School aims to give all students a 'goodly heritage': an exceptional education, a wide range of opportunities and extra-curricular activities, and a chance to be part of and contribute to a strong community.



11 Ark Burlington Danes is an all-through school backed by Ark. It aims to prepare pupils for university and a career of their choice.

13 Wren Academy Finchley is an all-through school with over 1,400 students. The school is proud of its successes and has twice been judged outstanding by OFSTED.

19 St Mary Magdalene Academy (SMMA) - A vibrant C of E sponsored school. At its heart is a clear focus on academic achievement together with a commitment to developing globally minded citizens who can be happy and successful.



20 St Mary Magdalene Academy (SMMA) The Courtyard is a free school for pupils with special educational needs.



21 Stepney All Saints is an outstanding (Ofsted 2015) languages college. Commended by the Minister of State for School Standards for their strong commitment to the teaching of EBacc.



22 The Urswick School a mixed secondary school located in the heart of Hackney is recognised as one of the best inner city secondary schools in the country.
