

DBS Checks and NON-UK Nationals

- Post Brexit immigration law changes affected which routes should be used for non-UK job applicants
- Linkage was created between the right to work in the UK and the right to obtain a DBS check for non-UK nationals
- Since July 2021, non-UK nationals seeking **paid** work have had to show a primary document evidencing their right to work in the UK as part of their DBS check
- As of 6th April 2022, holders of biometric residence permits, biometric residence cards and Frontier Worker permits need to have these documents checked via the Home Office's online system, rather than manually
- Non-UK nationals applying for volunteer roles do not have to provide a primary document but must be checked under the DBS's Route 1
