Essential Criteria

1. Qualifications

- 1.1 A degree
- 1.2 Qualified Teacher Status

2. Experience

- 2.1 Recent, successful teaching experience as a class teacher in the UK
- 2.2 Evidence of meeting the teacher standards
- 2.3 Evidence of how continuing professional development has had an impact on classroom teaching and learning

3. Knowledge

- 3.1 An up to date knowledge of the National Curriculum
- 3.2 A knowledge of, and a commitment to the effective safeguarding and welfare of children
- 3.3 Evidence of a range of effective teaching strategies to support children's learning
- 3.4 Experience of how assessment is used to inform teaching and learning
- 3.5 Confident use of ICT to inspire and motivate children.

4. Skills

- 4.1 An ability to demonstrate good classroom practice, evidenced in raising standards of achievement of all pupils and meeting performance targets
- 4.2 Evidence of effective planning, assessment and record keeping to meet the needs of all pupils including those with additional education needs
- 4.3 Evidence of an ability to meet the needs of pupils who have English as an additional language
- 4.4 Demonstrate positive classroom behaviour strategies and attitudes to learning
- 4.5 Demonstrate and ability to delegate and to manage support staff for maximum impact on learning.
